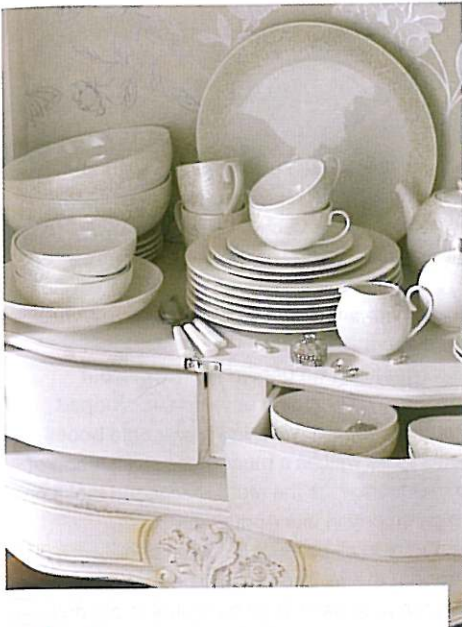

Pale, enchanting and quintessentially English, 'Asiatic Pheasants' from Burleigh is still a firm favourite with Brides. After 150 years in production, this range is one of the most recognisable and famous blue and white patterns of the Staffordshire pottery industry. With a reputation for quality and craftsmanship, Burleigh is made with care and pride using skills and experience passed down by generations. One of the last manufacturer's of transfer-printed ceramics, Burleigh designs are transferred from a hand-engraved copper roller onto tissue paper and then onto the piece. This was an English method which most Staffordshire Potteries were using in the late 18th and 19th Centuries to produce everyday wares. This method ensures that the pattern and its intensity of colour never fades.
